Notes on Chilled Semen - Your veterinarian will have examined your mare and determined that she will soon be ready for insemination. In most cases this will mean that she has a follicle 35mm or more in diameter and she will be receiving a drug to induce a predictable ovulation. Drugs such as Chorulon generally causes ovulation in around 36 hours, while Deslorelin generally takes around 41 hours. It is aimed to have semen in the mare at the time of ovulation, so she should ideally be inseminated within 1-2 days before the predicted ovulation. If prostaglandin is used to induce oestrus, it should be administered late in the week, so that semen can be collected and shipped in the following week within the normal hours for the courier services.

Collection and Dispatch - Agnes Banks Equine Clinic will collect semen at short notice, if necessary. Nevertheless, freight expenses become substantially greater when packages are not collected and delivered within the normal working week. The later in the day, the less reliable is overnight delivery. Please give stallion owners as much notice as reasonably practical. While we use standard collection and processing methods, and work with stallion owners to produce transported semen of a high quality, we can offer no guarantee with regard to the time of arrival, its condition on arrival, or its success in impregnating the mare. Even with live natural cover, 65% of normal mares will be expected to conceive on a single cycle - in other words, 35% won't conceive. We will undertake to either book semen for dispatch via a courier of our choice or co-operate with arrangement you have made yourself, and which are acceptable to us.
